Her son Steve recalls very fond memories of his mother and the powerful impact she had on the direction of the lives of her sons. "My mother was serious about life and she was, perhaps the most determined person I've ever known. She was caring and compassionate but doing what was right meant more to her than making others feel happy when they were on the wrong path," shared Steve.

Kittie loved studying her Bible. "I remember my mother wanting us to memorize Bible verses together when she was 90 years old. Eventually she laughed and said she thought I was doing most of the memorizing," shared Steve. Her strength in her faith was a witness to her family, friends, and the lives she touched for 96 years.
